The Sudan Studies Society of the United Kingdom (SSSUK) was established in 1987 to encourage and promote Sudanese Studies in the United Kingdom and abroad in all disciplines and levels. It is a registered charity (No. 328272). SSSUK's aim is to promote the study of the Sudan in all its aspects, provide a forum for discussion and debate and encourage cooperation among all those interested in the Sudan. Anyone with an interest in the Sudan, however general or specialised, is welcome to join. We are keen to attract members both in the UK and worldwide.

Membership

Membership is open to all regardless of nationality or country of residence.

Subscriptions

Membership subscriptions fall due in January each year. The current (2008/9) annual membership subscription rates are as follows

Members receive for their subscription:

1. Two issues a year of *Sudan Studies*, the Society's newsletter
2. The right to a reduced rate on copies of the Society's publications
3. The right to attend the Annual General Meeting
4. Advance notice and booking details of the triennial international Sudan Studies conferences.

New members receive the most recent issue of *Sudan Studies* on joining. The Annual General Meeting is usually held on the last Saturday of September on the same day as the Annual Symposium. A charge is usually made to defray expenses for the room rental and catering of the Symposium.

Paying the subscription

Cheques should be crossed and made payable to SSSUK. If you are paying from Europe, please pay in Euros. Payment can also be made in US\$. We regret that the Society is not able to accept payments in currencies other than Pounds Sterling, US Dollars, or Euros.

It is also possible to pay the subscription for three years in advance or by standing order. (To pay by standing order please also fill out the standing order form available from our website.)

If you are resident in Britain and pay income tax then please consider filling the Gift Aid form (also available from our website). This scheme allows SSSUK to claim back the tax you pay on your subscription at no cost to you.
